Learn German and gain access to the job market

The intensive cantonal language course at BFF Bern features 16 lessons per week and teaches language and communication skills for everyday and professional situations. Developing skills in communications and information technology is a key part of this process. All participants will be issued with their own personal notebook during the course. The following course is available:

For students aged 25 – 34:

we offer a one-year course from August to July. A1/A2 level under the European Reference Framework. The course begins in August. The fide-Test edu A1 exam will be held during the year and the fide-Test edu A2 exam at the end of the course. The focus on professional insertion from August onwards takes the form of the BPI 2-E, pre-vocational training, initial vocational training or directly in employment.

Well-prepared for the labour market

The objective of intensive language assistance is to ensure you are ready to begin a vocational qualification. It can take the form of a bridge-year programme, vocational basic training or entering the labour market for the first time.

Conditions for attendance

Attendees must:

- be able to read and write (Latin alphabet);
- have very little or no language ability in the official language of German;
- regularly attend lessons and be able to devote time to individual work;
- be highly motivated and eager to participate.
